(1963-1966)

Cat No	Title	Description
BBCV 4311	<i>An Unearthly Child</i>	With the Doctor's granddaughter and two teachers, the TARDIS is transported to the pre-civilized earth of 100,000 BC.
BBCV 4242	<i>The Daleks</i> <i>Part 1:</i> <i>The Dead Planet</i>  <i>Part 2:</i> <i>The Expedition</i>	An unedited classic - the Doctors first terrifying encounter with the Daleks.  Having escaped the clutches of the Daleks, the Doctor and his companions have to return to the Dalek city.  This first story featuring the Daleks turned Doctor Who into an overnight success with over eight million viewers.
BBCV 4743	<i>The Aztecs</i>	The TARDIS lands in 1430 inside the Tomb of Yetaza, one-time High Priestess of the Aztecs.
BBCV 4353	<i>The Dalek Invasion of the Earth</i> <i>Part 1 &amp; 2</i>	In the 22nd Century, the TARDIS lands in a menacing and deserted London, the Daleks now rule Earth.
BBCV 5378	<i>The Rescue/</i> <i>The Romans</i>	Two more exciting stories from different spectrums of time with the first Doctor which were transmitted consecutively in 1965.
BBCV 4405	<i>The Web Planet</i> <i>Part 1 &amp; 2</i>	With the Menoptra, the time travellers must discover how to immobilise the Zarbis, save the Menoptra from massacre.

BBCV 5005	<i>The Chase</i>	See <i>The Daleks Limited Edition Box Set</i> The Daleks have developed a Time Machine of their own design. With the TARDIS they engage in a frantic chase through space. (No longer available)

## PATRICK TROUGHTON

(1966-1969)

BBCV 4772	<i>The Tomb of the Cybermen</i>	The master tapes, thought lost forever, were discovered in Hong Kong in 1992 and rush released onto video.
BBCV 4406	<i>The Dominators</i>	With the help of the Doctor, the Dulcians outwit the Dominators and their robots, the Quarks.
BBCV 4352	<i>The Mind Robber</i>	The TARDIS has landed in the Land of Fiction, where things only exist when people believe in them.
BBCV 4974	<i>The Invasion</i>	Cybermen invade Earth, paralysing its population. This is the first UNIT story, and the last Cybermen story until 1975.
BBCV 4452	<i>The Krotons</i>	The Gonds try to overthrow their merciless rulers - the Krotons.
BBCV 4072	<i>The Seeds of Death</i>	Ice Warriors use the seed pods of deadly Martian fungus to extract oxygen and kill our fragile world.
BBCV 4310	<i>War Games</i> <i>Part 1 &amp; 2</i>	The last episode starring Troughton, the Doctor faces capture by his own people, the Time Lords, introduced for the first time in this story.

(1970-1974)

Cat No	Title	Description
BBCV 4107	<i>Spearhead from Space</i>	The Brigadier, Liz Shaw and UNIT enlist the Doctors help to defeat the Auton invasion.
BBCV 4990	<i>The Silurians</i>	After going into hibernation millions of years ago, the Silurians have been accidentally brought back to life by discharges from a nuclear energy research centre.
BBCV 5269	<i>The Inferno</i>	Professor Stahlam is attempting the first penetration of the earth's crust to tap into a new energy source at the core. But what will be the cost of Operation Inferno?
BBCV 4957	<i>Terror of the Autons</i>	This is the first story featuring the Master. His plan? To destroy humanity and silence the Doctor forever, with the help of the Autons.
BBCV 4742	<i>The Claws of Axos</i>	The Axons, humanoid and friendly creatures, are offering Earth the gift of Axonite but the Doctor has his suspicions
BBCV 4950	<i>The Daemons</i>	The greatest occult festival of the year prizes open the Devil's Hump bringing death & destruction? First recoloured story released.
BBCV 4109	<i>The Day of the Daleks</i>	A choice between the World peace and a terrifying future.
BBCV 4978	<i>The Curse of Peladon</i>	The Planet Peladon has applied for membership of the Galactic Federation. Not all though are in favour of the union.

BBCV 4245	<i>The Time Warrior</i>	A terrifying combination of past and future threatens the entire human race in the form of Linx, Sontaran fleet commander. This is the first story in which we hear the Time Lord's Planet Gallifrey named.
BBCV 4073	<i>Death to the Daleks</i>	A space plaque is attacking all creatures in the Galaxy but the only antidote can be found on the planet. Are the Daleks the cause of the plaque?
BBCV 4491	<i>Planet of the Spiders</i> <i>Part 1 &amp; 2</i>	This is Jon Pertwee's last and most dangerous adventure; the spiders have started their invasion of Earth.

## TOM BAKER

(1974-1981)

BBCV 4714	<i>Robot</i>	Plans for a new disintegrator gun are stolen by a robot. This story features UNIT.
BBCV 4244	<i>The Ark in Space</i>	The future population of Earth is stored away in deep freeze on the Ark, a fully automated space station. But the space station has been invaded by Wirrin, giant insect-like creatures.
BBCV 4643	<i>Sontaran Experiment</i> <i>The Genesis of the Daleks</i>	Styre, a Sontaran, is conducting cruel experiments on human captives. The Doctor meets Davros creator of the Daleks for the first time.

## TOM BAKER

(1974-1981)

Cat No	Title	Description
BBCV 4013	<i>Revenge of the Cybermen</i>	The Cybermen try to destroy Voga thereby destroying the gold mines, a deadly metal to them.
BBCV 4186	<i>Terror of the Zygons</i>	Part Cyborg, part-organic, the 'Loch Ness Monster' is the tool with which the Zygons hope to overpower Earth.
BBCV 5180	<i>Planet of Evil</i>	A distress call from the last planet in the known universe forces the TARDIS to commence emergency materialisation on Zeta Minor.
BBCV 4055	<i>Pyramids of Mars</i>	Sutekh is all-powerful and has been released by Scarman and his robot mummies with a view to destroying all life in the Cosmos.
BBCV 4388	<i>The Brain of Morbius</i>	Morbius an exiled Time Lord was the greatest criminal mind in the Galaxy long presumed dead, but Solon is in the process of bringing him back to life. Can the Doctor prevent Morbius from regaining absolute power?
BBCV 5377	<i>Seeds of Doom</i>	20th Century Earth. An Antarctic team digs up two mysterious pods which have laid buried for 20,000 years. So begins a terrible threat to the security of mankind...
BBCV 4642	<i>The Masque of Mandragora</i>	A wave of Mandragora energy hitches a ride with the TARDIS to 15th Century Earth. A new TARDIS Control room was introduced in this story.
BBCV 4645	<i>The Deadly Assassin</i>	The President of the Time Lords has been assassinated and the Doctor caught red-handed and convicted of the murder. The Doctor then discovers that his old adversary, the Master, is behind the plot.

BBCV 4108	<i>The Robots of Death</i>	A horde of killer robots try to seize absolute power of a desolate mining planet, driven on by an evil scientist.
BBCV 4187	<i>The Talons of Weng Chiang</i>	Disguised as the Chinese God Weng-Chiang, cult leader Magnus Greel initiates bizarre and horrific events against mankind.
BBCV 4941	<i>The Image of Fendahl</i>	Is the Fendahl really emerging from its 12 million year hibernation?
BBCV 5350	<i>Destiny of the Daleks</i>	The Doctor and the newly regenerated Romana land on Skaro where there is evidence of drilling taking place. But who is in charge of the operation?
BBCV 4492	<i>City of Death</i>	Can the Doctor unravel the mystery of the real Mona Lisa by travelling back to Renaissance Italy? Written by David Agnew, alias Douglas Adams and Graham Williams.
BBCV 4814	<i>Shada</i>	A book goes missing from a retired Time Lord's study. Who knows what power will be interested if it falls into the wrong hands. Released with a copy of the script.
BBCV 4973	<i>Keeper of Traken</i>	The Melkur becomes the new Keeper of Traken and reveals himself as the Master.
BBCV 4736	<i>Logopolis</i>	Logopolis, is a city inhabited by mathematicians. The Master, who has been interfering with the city in his plans to destroy the Doctor, accidentally causes it to stop functioning.

## PETER DAVISON

(1982-1984)

Cat No	Title	Description
BBCV 4737	<i>Castrovalva</i>	While trying to complete his regeneration. The Doctor finds Castrovalva. The Doctor soon realises the planet is not as tranquil as it seemed, but he is caught in a space time trap.
BBCV 5432	<i>Kinda</i>	Deva Loka is a beautiful, paradise planet with its inhabitants, the Kinda, gentle and seemingly primitive people. But why then are people disappearing one by one?
BBCV 5349	<i>Visitation/ Black Orchid</i>	Two stories transmitted consecutively in February and March 1982. The Visitation sees the Doctor back in 1666, when they inadvertently start the Great Fire. Black Orchid is the first purely historical story since The Highlanders.
BBCV 4840	<i>Earthshock</i>	Within a system of subterranean caves, the Cybermen reign supreme. This story features the long awaited return of the Cybermen.
BBCV 5199	<i>Arc of Infinity</i>	The Doctor's bio data Matrix is stolen by an alien who must bond with a Time Lord to remain in our dimension. Will the Doctor die in order to sever the bond?
BBCV 4874	<i>Mawdryn Undead</i>	The Black Guardian plans to assassinate the Doctor, with the help of an English public schoolboy. This story sees the return of the Brigadier.
BBCV 4890	<i>Terminus</i>	The Second in the Black Guardian trilogy.
BBCV 4891	<i>Enlightenment</i>	"I control the game, the Doctor's destiny. And soon he will be dead" (The Black Guardian). The Completion of the Black Guardian Trilogy.

BBCV 5143	<i>Resurrection of the Daleks</i>	Can the Daleks succeed with their plan to genetically engineer and duplicate the Doctor to kill the Time Lords Council.
BBCV 4713	<i>The Caves of Androzani</i>	Master android creator, Sharaz Jek, comes to the aid of the Doctor - is he really the saviour?

## COLIN BAKER

(1984-1986)

BBCV 4783	<i>The Twin Dilemma</i>	The Doctor's new incarnation behaves erratically, and he becomes involved with renegade Time Lord Azmael's plotting. Can the two twin mathematicians, Romulus and Remus be controlled?
BBCV 4962	<i>Vengeance of Varos</i>	Varos is a mining planet colonized by descendants from the criminally insane who thrive on public torture.
BBCV 5008	<i>The Trial of a Time Lord</i>	30th Anniversary Limited Edition Box Set On trial for his life, the Doctor is accused of meddling with the delicate balance of time itself. (No longer available)

(1987-PRESENT)

Cat No	Title	Description
BBCV 5181	<i>Dragonfire</i>	The Doctor teams up with Sabalom Glitz to go looking for a legendary dragon living in the depths of Ice World. This was the 150th Doctor Who story.
BBCV 5005	<i>Remembrance of the Daleks</i>	See <i>The Daleks Limited Edition Box Set</i> Two rival Dalek factions battle for possession of a cosmic power, known as the Hand of Omega. (No longer available)
BBCV 4888	<i>Silver Nemesis &amp; the Making of the Silver Nemesis (25th Anniversary)</i>	The statue Nemesis is capable of bestowing the power of life and death on any individual. Who will become its owner?
BBCV 5344	<i>Ghostlight</i>	Earth, 1883. At the heart of a Victorian House lies an alien ship. What secrets lie dormant there? Who or what is the alien presence Josiah?
BBCV 4453	<i>The Curse of Fenric</i>	Fenric rises from his Viking grave to summon his wolves to a killing rampage - evil must reign eternal.
