A treasure trove of images and historical information, this video is one to keep and watch time and again.

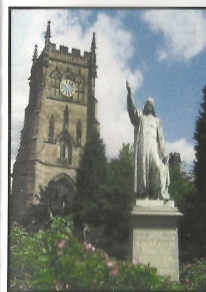

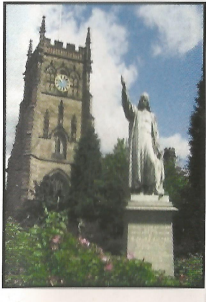

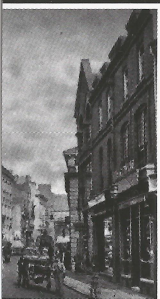
